MinistrySafe

Over 30 members of Calvary's family have signed up to see the MinistrySafe presentation and take the quiz on child sexual abuse. Child sexual abuse has become a severe problem. The single most important step a church can take is to train its people to understand the problem.

The procedure for the training is very simple. Once you have signed up with the office or on the paper on the table in the narthex your name will be entered with MinistrySafe. When you sign up you must put down your email address or indicate no email. For those with email you will receive an email from MinistrySafe, not from Alma Hazzard. Just click on the email from MinistrySafe and follow the directions for the presentation and quiz. Those without email will need to wait for Alma Hazzard to contact you so please put down your phone number when signing up.
