This week is the [Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2010](#). Christians throughout the world will be listening together to the promise and commission that are part of Christ's final words before his ascension: "You are witnesses of these things."

The Week of Prayer involves congregations and parishes all over the world. The production of the liturgical and biblical resources for the week of prayer has been jointly coordinated since 1968 by the World Council of Churches' Faith and Order Commission and the Roman Catholic Church's Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity.

Resources for the week include an introduction to the theme; a commentary; biblical reflections and prayers for the eight days; and reflection questions for you to ponder.
